## **GRADES FOUR THROUGH EIGHT REMOTE LEARNING PLAN**

For this Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, students will visit Schoology for online video lessons and activities. Some teachers may be reaching out to practice Google Meet; however, our complete blended learning plan will start next week. Advisors will be reaching out either today or tomorrow to students, and they will serve as the first point of contact regarding any questions or concerns you may have.

Beginning on Monday, March 23rd, all students in grades four through eight will follow their daily schedules. Teachers will begin each class with a Google Meet, and then prompt students to break into discussion or move to independent work. Teachers will remain available for questions either by remaining “live” on Google Meet or through email. Invitations will be sent via Gmail, as well as posted on Schoology. Although we expect all students to join their classes, there will be a recording posted on Schoology for those unable to attend due to extenuating circumstances. ### **General Guidelines and Expectations**

- All Middle School teachers will take attendance daily and communicate with their students via Schoology, email, Google Meet.
- Teachers will provide lessons via videos, Google Docs, websites, etc., as well as utilize Google Meet for live sessions. Written instructions will be attached to all assignments which include specific expectations, requirements, rubrics, and submission due dates/times.
- Students should expect to spend approximately 15-30 minutes “live” per class, as well as 30-60 minutes completing independent work (dependent upon course).
- Students will submit work daily via Schoology and may take online assessments. Teachers will review work nightly and post grades on a daily basis.
