The successful candidate will have grade level expertise in English and history, as well as the ability to engage lower school students in meaningful inquiry, problem solving, Project Based Learning, and collaborative exploration.

Essential Requirements, Duties, and Responsibilities:

- Bachelor's degree required; graduate degree preferred
- Two to five years of experience preferred
- Demonstrated commitment to equitable and inclusive practices, with respect to pedagogy, curriculum, instruction, and assessment
- A strong understanding of the developmental and learning needs of lower school children. This includes teaching math, literacy, phonics, reading and writing workshop, comprehension, science, mindset, study skills, and social/emotional skills.
- Ability to provide differentiated instruction for specific lessons, skills sets, and/or units of study.
- Enjoy working with an innovative grade-level team to foster the emotional well being and academic success of students
- Excellent classroom management
- Ability to collaborate with other faculty, speciality teachers, staff, and administration
- Excellent communication skills, both verbal and written

Additionally, successful candidates should demonstrate:

- An engaging teaching style
