

At Pardes, we want to provide your child with tools that lead to understanding and application of learning. Our teachers model lessons with intentionality and every class has space for students to reflect on their learning experience.



By using a common language that focuses on *chesed* (kindness) and *kavod* (respect), your lower school child will develop the skills to:

- Accurately identify and express their emotions
- Resolve peer conflict and show empathy towards one another
- Learn and practice independent problem-solving skills
- Have their needs met in a prosocial way

As a lower school student at Pardes, your child will become a curious, forward-thinking learner who is confident, engaged, and equipped for the future. Our students are successful in middle school and beyond because we offer more than differeentiated instruction.





### **Project Based Learning**

Students build curriculum-aligned skills while working together to solve complex, real world problems. Instead of passively listening to a teacher provide instructions and facts, **your child will be actively engaged in asking questions, seeking answers, and solving meaningful problems.** 

#### **STEAM** (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math)

- Students are engrossed in hands-on activities that develop scientific thinking and a love of scientific inquiry
- Our math program is grounded in contemporary research that teaches foundational skills in concert with a mathematical mindset
- A Makerspace provides an environment where even our youngest students have ample opportunities to engage in engineering and design challenges fostering creativity, risk-taking, and exploration
- Pardes values the importance of the arts, and elementary-aged students are engaged in visual and performing arts classes weekly


- You will be joining a community of shared values, where you can grow your network of friends
